# ARMY RECRUITMENT RALLY AT DELHI FOR ENROLMENT OF AGNIVEERS UNDER AGNIPATH SCHEME FROM 07 TO 27 SEPT 2022

REGISTRATION WILL BE OPEN FROM 05 JUL 2022 TO 04 AUG 2022 FOR AGNIVEER GENERAL DUTY, AGNIVEER TECHNICAL, AGNIVEER TECHNICAL (AVIATION/AMMUNITION EXAMINER), AGNIVEER CLERK/ STORE KEEPER TECHNICAL, AGNIVEER TRADESMAN 10<sup>TH</sup> PASS AND AGNIVEER TRADESMAN 8<sup>TH</sup> PASS FOR CANDIDATES FROM DELHI, GURUGRAM, FARIDABAD, MEWAT AND PALWAL

# <u>Note</u> : The date and venue are tentative and subject to change. Final date and venue will be mentioned in the Admit Card issued for the Rally.

# Agnipath Scheme

1. The salient aspects of terms and conditions of service for persons enrolled through the Agnipath Scheme for service in the IA are mentioned in the succeeding paragraphs.

### 2. <u>Terms and Conditions</u>.

### (a) <u>Enrolment</u>.

(i) Candidates will be enrolled under Army Act 1950 for service duration of four (04) years including the training period.

(ii) Agniveers so enrolled will be subject to Army Act 1950 and will be liable to go wherever ordered, by land, sea or air.

(iii) Agniveers enrolled under the scheme, will not be eligible for any kind of Pension or Gratuity.

### (b) Service.

(I) Service of Agniveers will commence from the date of enrolment.

(ii) Agniveers would form a distinct rank in the IA, different from any other existing ranks.

(iii) Leave, Uniform, Pay & Allowances during the service period of four years will be governed by orders and instructions in respect of such individuals issued by the Government of India (GOI) from time to time.

(iv) Agniveeers will be liable to be assigned any duty in organisational interest, as decided from time to time.

(v) Personnel enrolled through Agniveers Scheme, will be required to undergo periodical medical check-ups and physical/ written/ field tests as governed by orders issued. The performance so demonstrated would be considered for subsequent offer for enrolment in the Regular Cadre.

(vi) Agniveers can be posted to any regiment/unit and can be further transferred in organisational interest.

### (c) **Discharge**.

(i) All Agniveers will be discharged on completion of four years of service.

(ii) On discharge after completion of four years, Agniveers will be paid a 'Seva Nidhi' package to enable them to return to the society for pursuing employment in other sectors.

(iii) Agniveers will not be eligible for any kind of pension or gratuity, neither will they be eligible for Ex Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS), Canteen Stores Department (CSD) facilities, Ex Serviceman status and other related benefits.

(iv) Agniveers will be barred from disclosing classified information gained during service to any unauthorised person or source under Official Secrets Act, 1923.

#### (d) Enrolment for Regular Cadre.

(i) Based on organizational requirements and policies promulgated Agniveers who are completing their engagement period in each batch will be offered an opportunity to apply for enrolment in the regular cadre of IA. These applications will be considered in a centralised manner by the army based on an objective criteria including performance during their engagement period and not more than 25% of each specific batch of Agniveers will be enrolled in regular cadre of the IA, post completion of their four years engagement period.

(ii) Agniveers so enrolled as regular cadre would be required to serve for a further engagement period of 15 years and will be governed by terms and conditions of service (of Junior Commissioned Officers/Other Ranks in IA) currently in vogue (as amended from time to time). Agniveers will not have any right to be selected. Selection will be exclusive jurisdiction of the IA.

(iii) With introduction of this Scheme, the enrolment of Soldiers in the regular cadre of IA, except technical cadres of Medical Branch, will be available only to those personnel who have completed their engagement period as Agniveer.

#### 3. <u>Employability</u>.

(a) Agniveers will be liable to be assigned any duty in organisational interest, as decided from time to time.

(b) Agniveers can be posted to any regiment/ unit and can be further transferred to other regiments/ units in organisational interest.

4. **Leave**. Grant of leave will be subject to exigencies of service. The following leave may be applicable for Agniveers during their engagement period :-

- (a) <u>Annual Leave</u>. Upto 30 days per year.
- (c) <u>Sick Leave</u>. Based on medical advice.

# 5. Pay, Allowances & Allied Benefits.

### (a) Agniveer Package.

(i) The pay & emoluments of Agniveers will be as given below :-

(aa) <u>Year 1</u>	. Customised Package	- ₹ 30,000/- (plus applicable allowances).
(ab) <u>Year 2</u>	. Customised Package	- ₹ 33,000/- (plus applicable allowances).
(ac) <u>Year 3</u>	. Customised Package	- ₹ 36,500/- (plus applicable allowances).
(ad) <u>Year 4</u>	. Customised Package	- ₹ 40,000/- (plus applicable allowances).

(ii) From the above package, 30% will be compulsorily deposited ever month in a corpus which will be matched by the GOI. Balance amount less the corpus contribution will be the in-hand component.

(b) <u>Seva Nidhi Package</u>. On discharge at 4 years, the corpus of ₹5.02 lakhs will be matched by the GOI, an amount of ₹10.04 lakhs and accrued interest will be given to the Agniveers. In case of Agniveers who are subsequently selected for enrolment in IA as regular cadre, the "Seva Nidhi" package to be paid to them will comprise only their contribution including accrued interest thereon. In the case of Agniveers exiting service before the end of their engagement period on their own request, the individual's Seva Nidhi package, accumulated as on date, will be paid with the applicable rate of interest. In such cases, no Govt contribution to Seva Nidhi Package will be entitled. The "Seva Nidhi" will be exempt from Income Tax.

(c) <u>Payment Modality – Seva Nidhi Package</u>. Two options to receive Seva Nidhi package will be provided to each Agniveer, with an aim to provide financial loans for self employment/ entrepreneurship through a bank Guarantee as also to meet immediate/ incidental expenses, on exit. Firm details will be promulgated separately.

(d) <u>Allowances</u>. The Agniveer pay is a composite package and he will not be eligible for any Dearness Allowance and Military Service Pay. He will get applicable Risk & Hardship, Ration, Dress and Travel allowances as decided by the GOI from time to time.

(e) Agniveers will be exempted from making any contribution in Armed Forces Personnel Provident Fund or any other Provident Fund.

(f) There shall be no entitlement towards gratuity or pensionary benefits for Agniveers enrolled through this Scheme.

6. <u>Life Insurance Cover</u>. Agniveer will be provided non-contributory life insurance cover of 48 lakhs for the duration of their engagement period and they will not be eligible for Army Group Insurance Fund (AGIF) Schemes / benefits.

# 7. <u>Termination/ Release from Service</u>.

(a) The maximum period of service for Agniveers will be as enumerated at Para 2 above. However, the services of Agniveers under this scheme may be terminated at any time in accordance with the Army Act 1950.

(b) Release at own request prior to completion of terms of engagement of Agniveers is not permitted. However, in most exceptional cases, personnel enrolled under this scheme may be released, if sanctioned by competent authority.

8. <u>Benefits for Personnel Exiting at Four Years of Service</u>. After completing four years of service (as applicable), the following benefits will be offered to the exiting individuals:-

(a) <u>Seva Nidhi Package</u>. Refer Para 5 (b) above. The corpus generated after four years of contribution will be paid to the exiting Agniveers.

(b) <u>Agniveer' Skill Certificate</u>. At the end of engagement period, a detailed Skill set certificate will be provided to the Agniveers, highlighting the skills and level of competency acquired by the personnel during their engagement period.

(c) <u>**Class 12th Certificate**</u>. Agniveers who have been enrolled after qualifying Class 10th, a certificate for 12th (equivalent) will be given on completion of their 4 years engagement period, based on skills attained. Detailed instructions shall be issued separately.

# Army Rect Rally 2022-23

9. Army Recruitment Rally will be held for all eligible candidates of *Delhi, Gurugram, Faridabad, Mewat and Palwal* for categories Agniveer General Duty, Agniveer Technical, Agniveer Technical (Aviation/Ammunition Examiner), Agniveer Clerk/ Store Keeper Technical, Agniveer Tradesman 10<sup>th</sup> Pass and Agniveer Tradesman 8<sup>th</sup> Pass at Rajiv Gandhi Stadium, Bawana, Delhi. Online registration is mandatory and will be open from 01 Jul 2022 onwards. Admit Cards for the rally will be sent through registered e-mail. Candidates should reach the venue on given date and time as mentioned in the Admit Cards. Any candidate who fails to submit this application will not be allowed to participate in the Rally. Candidate should confirm from their application history that their present online application is submitted successfully.

# 10. **Procedure For Online Registration**.

(a) All candidates to log in to **joinindianarmy.nic.in**, check their eligibility status and create their profile.

(b) Online Registration (submission of application) will commence from **05 Jul 2022** and close on **04 Aug 2022**.

(c) Candidates will login on and after **20 Aug 2022** and take printout of the admit card which they will carry to Rally Site.

(d) Candidates will be allowed to participate in the Rally if they produce Admit Card. Affidavit for details duly attested by notary and as per format given at Appx.

11. Army Recruitment Rally under Agnipath scheme will be held at Rajiv Gandhi Stadium, Bawana, Delhi. Admit Card for the rally will be sent through registered email from 20 Aug 2022 onwards. Candidates shall reach the venue on given date and time as mentioned in Admit Card.

### Physical Measurement (At Rally Site)

Physical measurement will be carried out as per the Physical standards.

### Medical Test

(a) At the Rally Site as per the laid down medical standards.

(b) Unfit candidates will be referred to MH for specialist review. Candidates to report to designated Military Hospital within 4 days from referral and review medical exam to be completed by Military Hospital within 10 days.

# Written Test through Common Entrance Examination (CEE)

(a) Will be conducted for medically fit candidates at nominated venue. Date and time of written test will be intimated at rally site and through Admit Cards.

(b) Admit Card for the CEE for all candidates will be issued at **IRO, Delhi** on dates fixed at the rally site.

(c) Admit Card for the CEE for the review Fit cases will be issued after getting medically fit by concerned specialist/ specialists at MH. Admit card for relaxation cases will be issued post verification of NCC/ Sports/ Relationship certificate from concerned authorities.

(d) Relaxation cases/ bonus marks cases will not be awarded any extra marks in CEE if for any reason whatsoever their documents are not verified till conduct of CEE.

17. Candidates are required to bring following documents/ certificate in original with two attested photocopies with them to the rally site. List attached as per Appendix 'A'.

(a) <u>Admit Card</u>. Printed on Laser Printer on good quality paper (Do not shrink the size).

(b) <u>Photograph</u>. Twenty (20) copies of unattested Passport size colour photos developed on good quality photo paper in white background not more than three months old. Computerised/ photocopied/ shopped photos will **NOT be accepted. Photos must be with proper hair cut and clean shave (except Sikh Candidates).** 

### (c) Education Certificate & Date of Birth.

(i) Matriculation/ Intermediate/ 10+ 2/ Graduation Certificates & Marks Sheet should be brought in Original (from a recognized Board of Education).

(ii) For 8<sup>th</sup> class pass, Original copy of 8<sup>th</sup> class certificate along with Transfer Certificate will be accepted with signature & office stamp of Principal of School & countersigned by District Education Officer.

(iii) Candidates whose Original Certificates has not been received from the concerned Education Board or have deposited their Original Certificates to other educational institutes, will be permitted to attend Rally based on photocopy of their Educational / Provisional / Online Certificate duly attested by School / College/ Head of Institute and Candidates sign and thumb impression on the rear of the certificates. However, verification of original will be carried out after Rally Stage and dispatch will be only after the original certificates are deposited.

(iv) For below Matriculation Candidates, Original copy of Result sheet of Cl 8<sup>th</sup> or School Leaving or School Transfer Certificate in original with Date of Birth or certified extract from municipal or Village Birth Register or in the case of Christians, original Baptism certificate will be accepted as proof of Date of Birth.

(v) Candidates with Matric Certificate from **Open School** should bring **School** Leaving Certificate in original mentioning Date of Birth and countersigned by District Education Officer. If School leaving certificate countersigned by District Education Officer is not produced, they are liable to be rejected at Rally Site or later.

(vi) **10<sup>th</sup>/ 12<sup>th</sup> Class Certificate** in original will be brought to Rally site as proof of Date of Birth & for document verification and failure to do so will result in rejection of candidate. Higher Secondary School Certificate giving Date of Birth shall be accepted in lieu of Matriculation/ Equivalent Certificate.

(vii) List of Education Board recognized by State Governments / UT administrations is attach as **Appendix 'B'** will only be accepted.

(viii) Enrolling Officer may call for additional proofs as necessary regarding Educational Qualifications & Date of Birth.

(d) <u>Domicile Certificate</u>. While appearing for the Rally, candidate will produce Digital Nativity Certificate with photograph issued by Tehshildar/ District Magistrate. Only computer-generated Nativity certificate which can be verified from Govt website will be accepted. In case of doubt about Nativity of a candidate, ink signed copy of verification by District Official will be produced. Nativity/ Domicile/ Permanent Resident Certificate or Mool Niwas/ Sthai Niwas Praman Patra (preferably with photograph) and signed by any authorized signatory of the state and produced in original will be accepted.

(e) <u>**Caste Certificate.</u>** Digital Caste Certificate affixed with photograph of the candidate issued by the Tehsildar/ District Magistrate. Certificate produced should be verifiable from the Govt. Websites.</u>

(f) <u>Religion Certificate</u>. Religion Certificate issued by the Tehsildar/ SDM (if religion as "SIKH/ HINDU / MUSLIM/ CHRISTIAN" is not mentioned in caste certificate).

(g) <u>School Character Certificate</u>. School Character Certificate issued by the School/College Principal/Headmaster where the candidates last studied.

(h) <u>Character Certificate</u>. Character Certificate with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch/ Municipal Corporation within last six months.

(j) <u>Unmarried Certificate</u>. Unmarried Certificate for candidates less than 21 years of age with photo issued by Village Sarpanch/ Municipal Corporation within last six months.

(k) <u>Affidavit</u>. Duly signed by candidates on Rs 10/- Non Judicial Stamp Paper as per specimen duly attested by notary will be submitted by candidate at the Rally Site without fail. Format of affidavit attached as per Appendix 'C'. Submission of Affidavit is Mandatory to gain entry into the Rally. Candidates WILL NOT BE PERMITTED to enter the rally without affidavit.

(I) <u>Single Bank A/C, PAN Card & AADHAR Card</u>. Single Bank A/C, PAN Card & Aadhar Card are mandatory documents for final enrolment for purpose of Pay & allowances and other social benefits scheme.

(m) **Police Character Certificate**. Character certificate, not more than **six months old**, issued by Police Station of the village or tehsil of the candidate is mandatory.

(n) <u>Sarpanch/ Nagar Sewak (Residence Proof)</u>. Residence proof of not more than **six months old**, issued by Sarpanch of the village or Nagar Sewak of the candidate is mandatory.

(o) <u>Vaccination Certificate</u>. Covid-19 Vaccination cert as issued online should be carried to rally site.

(p) <u>**Relationship Certificate**</u>. SOS/SOEX/SOW/SOWW Candidates are required to produce the following documents:-

(i) Relationship certificate issued from respective Record Office only duly signed by Record Officer with Personal Number, Rank, Name and particular of the Record Officer issuing the Relationship Certificate with office seal/stamp is endorsed. Relationship certificate should bear water marks of the concern Records. Format of Relationship Certificate attached as per Appendix 'D'

(ii) A declaration to the effect as mentioned in Affidavit on Ten Rupees Non Judicial Stamp paper prepared by the ESM duly signed by 1<sup>st</sup> Class/Executive/Judicial Magistrate is required to be submitted by the candidate at rally site. **Format of affidavit is attached as per Appendix 'E'**.

(iii) **Original Discharge Book of Ex-Servicemen also to be produced**. Name and date of birth of the candidate must have been recorded in it.

### <u>NOTE</u> :- THE ENROLLING OFFICER WILL HAVE THE RIGHT TO REJECT ANY CANDIDATE AT ANY STAGE IN CASE REQUISITE DOCUMENTS ARE NOT PROVIDED.

(q) <u>NCC Certificate</u>. NCC A/ B/ C Certificate and Republic Day Parade certificate should have photograph of the candidate duly attested by issuing authority. Provisional NCC A/B/C pass certificates will only be accepted if authenticated by concerned NCC Group Commanders. Provisional certificates are accepted only during the notified rally duration, neither earlier nor late.

### (r) <u>Sports Certificate</u>.

(i) Sportsmen who have represented India at international level and State at National level within the last two years (for list of sports under which relaxation in physical standards is admissible, attention is invited to <u>www.joinindianarmy.nic.in</u> website).

(ii) Sportsmen who have represented District at State level and University team in inter university championship within last two years (Sports Certificate should be with registration number and from government recognized sport institutes / bodies).

# (iii) List of Sports. List of Sports for enrolment is attached as Appendix 'F'.

# <u>NOTE</u> :- No bonus marks are to be allotted unless the certificate (Relationship/ sports/ NCC) have been verified.

(s) <u>No Claim Certificate</u>. No claim certificate with photograph duly signed by self and father/ mother/ guardian and countersigned by Village Sarpanch/ MC/ District Administration within last six months. (Candidate will be appearing in rally at own will and risk and no claim for any injury or loss sustained during the rally will be entertained). Format attached as **Appendix 'G'**.

(t) <u>Certificate of Bonus Marks</u>. All original certificates/ photocopies duly attested pertaining to Bonus marks will be accepted only during the Rally. No certificates to include NCC Certificates, Sports Certificate, Relationship Certificate or any other certificates to claim Bonus Marks/ Relaxation would be accepted after termination of the Rally. An undertaking to the effect will be obtain from the candidate.

### 19. Special Instructions

(a) Any candidate who had not received admit card 05 days prior to the Rally, may approach <u>Independent Recruiting Office, Delhi</u> for further clarification.

(b) Candidates can apply in only one category. If anyone is found registered for multiple trade/ category, he will be disqualified and will not be considered for any trade/ category. Choose wisely before applying. For online registration and online application, assistance will also be provided to candidates at IRO Delhi on working days from 1000 Hours to 1300 hours.

(c) <u>01 October 2022</u> will be taken as effective date of determining age eligible for candidate. 29. <u>Use of Performance Enhancing Drugs</u>. Use of any kind of performance enhancing drugs is strictly banned. Any candidate found to have used the same will be debarred from further screening.

(a) Candidates belonging to tribal communities/from tribal areas, are permitted to have permanent body tattoos on any part of the body, as per existing customs and traditions of the said tribe to which a candidate belongs. 32. Mobile phones, smart watches and any other recording devices are not permitted at the rally site and at the time CEE.

33. CEE for the selected candidates will be held tentatively in the month of Nov 2022.

34. Negative marking will be applicable in CEE.

35. Procedure for applying for online registration on <u>www.joinindianarmy.nic.in</u> website in att as **Appendix 'J'**.

36. Candidates may have to present themselves at rally site for two to three times. Candidates should make arrangements for stay under their own arrangements.

37. Candidates are advised in their own interest to undergo medical exam before coming for selection especially with respect to flat foot, poor vision, deformities and physical measurements. All are advised to ensure that their ears are free of wax by getting it cleaned by a doctor prior to the rally.

38. If 180 days or more lapse between screening medical at the rally and dispatch, medical will be done again and unfit candidates in this review will not be recruited.

39. <u>Vaccination Certificate</u>. All candidates appearing for rally should be fully vaccinated for Covid-19. The certificate should be produced to authorities upon asking.

40. No use of contact lenses.

41. **Result of written examination will be declared on the official website joinindianarmy.nic.in.** No separate letter will be sent to the candidate. It is responsibility of candidate to check his result and report to IRO for documentation.

42.
