<u>Note</u>: The date and venue are tentative and subject to change. Final date and venue will be mentioned in the Admit Card issued for the Rally.

Special Instructions

1. The salient aspects of terms and conditions of service for persons enrolled through the Agnipath Scheme for service in the Indian Army(IA) are mentioned in the succeeding paragraphs.

2. Terms and Conditions.

(a) Enrolment.

- (i) Candidates will be enrolled under Army Act 1950 for a service duration of four (04) years including the training period.
- (ii) Agniveers so enrolled will be subject to Army Act 1950 and will be liable to go wherever ordered, by land, sea or air.
- (iii) Agniveers enrolled under the scheme, will not be eligible for any kind of Pension or Gratuity.

(b) Service.

- (i) Service of Agniveers will commence from the date of enrolment.
- (ii) Agniveers would form a distinct rank in the IA, different from any other existing ranks.

- (iii) Leave, Uniform, Pay & Allowances during the service period of four years will be governed by orders and instructions in respect of such individuals issued by the Government of India (GOI) from time to time.
- (iv) Agniveers will be liable to be assigned any duty in organisational interest, as decided from time to time.
- (v) Personnel enrolled through Agnipath Scheme, will be required to undergo periodical medical check-ups and physical/ written/ field tests as governed by orders issued. The performance so demonstrated would be considered for subsequent offer for enrolment in the Regular Cadre.
- (vi) Agniveers can be posted to any regiment/ unit and can be further transferred in organizational interest.

(c) Discharge.

- (i) All Agniveers will be discharged on completion of four years of service.
- (ii) On discharge after completion of four years, Agniveers will be paid a "Seva Nidhi" package to enable them to return to the society for pursuing employment in other sectors.
- (iii) Agniveers will not be eligible for any kind of pension or gratuity, neither will they be eligible for Ex Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS), Canteen Stores Department (CSD) facilities, Ex Serviceman status and other related benefits.
- (iv) Agniveers will be barred from disclosing classified information gained during service to any unauthorised person or source under Official Secrets Act 1923.

(d) Enrolment for Regular Cadre.

- (i) Based on organisational requirements and policies promulgated, Agniveers who are completing their engagement period in each batch will be offered an opportunity to apply for enrolment in the regular cadre of IA. These applications will be considered in a centralised manner by the Army based on an objective criteria including performance during their engagement period and not more than 25% of each specific batch of Agniveers will be enrolled in regular cadre of the IA, post completion of their four years engagement period.
- (ii) Agniveers so enrolled as regular cadre would be required to serve for a further engagement period of 15 years and will be governed by terms and conditions of service (of Junior Commissioned Officers/ Other Ranks in IA) currently in vogue (as amended from time to time). Agniveers will not have any right to be selected. Selection will be exclusive jurisdiction of the IA.
- (iii) With introduction of this Scheme, the enrolment of Soldiers in the regular cadre of IA, except technical cadres of Medical Branch, will be available only to those personnel who have completed their engagement period as Agniveer.

3. **Employability**.

- (a) Agniveers will be liable to be assigned any duty in organisational interest, as decided from time to time.
- (b) Agniveers can be posted to any regiment/ unit and can be further transferred to other regiment/ units in organisational interest.
- 4. <u>Leave</u>. Grant of leave will be subject to exigencies of service. The following leave may be applicable for Agniveers during their engagement period:-
 - (a) Annual Leave. Upto 30 days per year.
 - (b) **Sick Leave**. Based on medical advice.

5. Pay, Allowances & Allied Benefits.

(a) **Agniveer Package**.

- (i) The pay & emoluments of Agniveers will be as given below :-
 - (aa) <u>Year 1</u>. Customised Package Rs 30,000/- (plus applicable allowances).
 - (ab) <u>Year 2</u>. Customised Package Rs 33,000/- (plus applicable allowances).
 - (ac) <u>Year 3</u>. Customised Package Rs 36,500/- (plus applicable allowances).
 - (ad) Year 4. Customised Package Rs 40,000/- (plus applicable allowances).
- (ii) From the above package, 30% will be compulsorily deposited every month in a corpus which will be matched by the GOI. Balance amount less the corpus contribution will be the in-hand component.
- (b) "Seva Nidhi" Package. On discharge at 4 years, the corpus of ₹5.02 lakhs will be matched by the GOI, an amount of ₹10.04 lakhs and accrued interest will be given to the Agniveers. In case of Agniveers who are subsequently selected for enrolment in IA as regular cadre, the "Seva Nidhi" package to be paid to them will comprise only their contribution including accrued interest thereon. In the case of Agniveers exiting service before the end of their engagement period on their own request, the individual's "Seva Nidhi" package, accumulated as on date, will be paid with the applicable rate of interest. In such cases, no Government contribution to "Seva Nidhi" package will be entitled. The "Seva Nidhi" will be exempt from Income Tax.
- (c) <u>Payment Modality "Seva Nidhi" Package</u>. Two options to receive "Seva Nidhi" package will be provided to each Agniveer, with an aim to provide financial loans for self employment/ entrepreneurship through a bank Guarantee as also to meet immediate/ incidental expenses, on exit. Firm details will be promulgated separately.

- (d) <u>Allowances</u>. The Agniveer pay is a composite package and he will not be eligible for any Dearness Allowance and Military Service Pay. He will get applicable Risk & Hardship, Ration, Dress and Travel allowances as decided by the GOI from time to time.
- (e) Agniveers will be exempted from making any contribution in Armed Forces Personnel Provident Fund or any other Provident Fund.
- (f) There shall be no entitlement towards gratuity or pensionary benefits for Agniveers enrolled through this Scheme.
- 6. <u>Life Insurance Cover</u>. Agniveer will be provided non-contributory life insurance cover of ₹ 48 lakhs for the duration of their engagement period and they will not be eligible for Army Group Insurance Fund (AGIF) Scheme/ benefits.

7. <u>Termination/ Release from Service</u>.

- (a) The maximum period of service for Agniveers will be as enumerated at Para 2 above. However, the services of Agniveers under this scheme may be terminated at any time in accordance with the Army Act 1950.
- (b) Release at own request prior to completion of terms of engagement of Agniveers is not permitted. However, in most exceptional cases, personnel enrolled under this scheme may be released, if sanctioned by competent authority.
- 8. <u>Benefits for Personnel Exiting at Four Years of Service</u>. After completing four years of service (as applicable), the following benefits will be offered to the exiting individuals:-
 - (a) "Seva Nidhi" Package. Refer Para 5 (b) above. The corpus generated after four years of contribution will be paid to the exiting Agniveers.
 - (b) <u>'Agniveer' Skill Certificate</u>. At the end of engagement period, a detailed Skill set certificate will be provided to the Agniveers, highlighting the skills and level of competency acquired by the personnel during their engagement period.
 - (c) <u>Class 12th Certificate</u>. Agniveers who have been enrolled after qualifying Class 10th, a certificate for 12th (equivalent) will be given on completion of their 4 years engagement period, based on skills attained. Detailed instruction shall be issued separately.


9. **Procedure for Online Registration**.

- (a) All candidates to log in to <u>www.joinindianarmy.nic.in</u>, check their eligibility status and create their profile by registering on the website.
- (b) Online Registration (Submission of application) for this Rally will commence on **05 August 2022.** The window for registration will remain open till **03 September 2022**.
- (c) Kindly read instructions for registration and filling application forms carefully as given in the **www.joinindianarmy.nic.in** website.

(d) Candidates will login after **18 September 2022** and take printout of the admit card which they will carry to Rally Site.

[Note: Candidates will be allowed to participate in the Rally only if they produce Admit Card].

- 1. Candidates are requested to choose trade very carefully while doing online registration. Candidate will not be allowed to change their trade at a later stage.
- 2. Any candidate not meeting the basic QR of category he has applied for will not be allowed to change category even if he is meeting the QR of other category.
- 3. # The upper age limit has been relaxed from 21 years to 23 years as a Onetime measure only for the Recruiting Year 2022-23.
- 4. **Special Physical standards** applicable for **Adivasi Candidates** of all categories are as follows:-
 - (a) Minimum Height 162 cms, Minimum Weight 48 Kgs (Refer JIA website for details) and Minimum Chest 77cm (+5 cm expansion).
 - (b) A further relaxation of 1 cm in chest (76 cms) and 2 Kgs in weight (46 kgs) is applicable to Adivasi candidates applying for Agniveer Tradesman 10th Pass and 8th Pass category.
 - (c) Adivasi Candidates must bring Caste certificate duly signed/countersigned by District Magistrate only.

Physical Measurement (At Rally Site)

Physical measurements will be carried out as per the Physical Standards listed at Para 12 above.

Medical Test

- (a) As per laid down medical standards at the Rally Site.
- (b) Medical standards and procedure of medical examination is as uploaded on the JIA website.
- (c) Unfit candidates will be referred to MH / CH / BH for specialist review (the opinion of the specialist is final and no further review is permissible). Candidates to report to designate Military Hospital within 5 days from referral and review medical exam to be completed by Military Hospital within 14 days as per policy. Candidates referred for specialist review should report back to Recruiting Office (HQ) Danapur for issue of admit card for CEE in case declared FIT.
- (d) If 180 days or more lapse between the medical at the Rally and dispatch, medical will be done again and unfit candidates in this review will not be recruited.

Written Test Through Common Entrance Examination (CEE)

- (a) Will be conducted for medically fit candidates at nominated venue. Location, date and time of written test will be intimated at rally site and through Admit Cards.
- (b) Admit Card for the CEE for the rally fit candidates will be issued at Rally Site itself.
- (c) Admit Card for the CEE for the review fit cases will be issued by Recruiting Office (HQ) Danapur on the date to be intimated once candidates report to the Recruiting Office after being declared medically fit by concerned specialist/specialists at MH / CH / BH.
- 15. <u>Documents to be Brought to Rally Site</u>. Candidates are required to bring following documents/ certificates in **original along with two attested photocopies** with them to the rally site:-
 - (a) <u>Admit Card</u>. Printed on Laser Printer on good quality paper (Do not shrink the size).
 - (b) <u>Photographs</u>. Twenty (20) copies of unattested Passport size colour photographs developed on good quality photographic paper in white background not more than three months old. Computerised/ photocopied/ photo shopped photographs will NOT be accepted. Photographs must be with proper haircut and clean shave (except SIKH Candidates).

(c) Education Certificates.

- (i) Education Certificates with Marks Sheets, and Board Certificates in **original** of all educational qualifications achieved by candidate i.e Matric/Intermediate etc from recognised School/ College/ Board/ University.
- (ii) Provisional/ online education certificate should be certified and ink signed by the head of the educational institution of concerned Board/University. School Leaving Certificate (SLC) and College Leaving Certificate (CLC) will be carried by all the candidates.
- (iii) Candidates with matric certificate from Open School and 8th pass candidates who have applied for Agniveer tradesman (All Arms) 8th pass category should bring School Leaving Certificate countersigned by BEO/DEO.
- (iv) Candidates having ITI course of minimum one/two year(s)/diploma in required field with NSQF level 4 or above and applying for Agniveer Technical (All Arms) to bring this certificate/diploma.
- (v) Candidates for Agniveer Clk/ SKT category having 'O' level (IT) course certificate issued by NIELIT and having higher level IT Course Certificate from NIELIT i.e. 'A', 'B' or 'C' level. ('O' level (IT) course certificate under DOEACC scheme issued only by NIELIT on or after 01 January 2020 to carry the same to avail bonus marks.
- (vi) List of Education Boards recognized by State Governments/UT administrations attached as **Appendix 'B'** will only be accepted.

- (d) <u>Domicile (Nativity) Certificate</u>. Domicile (Nativity) Certificate generated online through Bihar Government website and digitally signed by Circle Officer and countersigned by SDO/Tehsildar/ District Magistrate which can be verified from Govt web site will only be acceptable.
- (e) <u>Caste Certificate</u>. Caste Certificate generated online through Bihar Government website and digitally signed by Circle Officer and countersigned by SDO/Tehsildar/District Magistrate which can be verified from Govt web site will only be accepted. For Adivasi candidates caste certificate issued in a similar manner but countersigned and stamped by District Magistrate only will be acceptable.
- (f) <u>Religion Certificate</u>. Religion Certificate to be issued by the Tehsildar/ SDM. (if religion as "SIKH/HINDU/MUSLIM/CHRISTIAN" is not mentioned in caste certificate).
- (g) <u>School Character Certificate</u>. School Character Certificate issued by the School/ College Principal/ Headmaster where the candidate has last studied.
- (h) <u>Character Certificate</u>. Character Certificate with photograph affixed on the certificate issued by Village Sarpanch/ Municipal Corporation within last six months from the date of despatch (Certificate issued by Mukhia will not be acceptable).
- (j) <u>Character Certificate Issued by SP/SSP Office</u>. Character Certificate duly affixed with individual's photograph issued **digitally by SP/SSP Office of district concerned within last six months** which can be verified from Govt web site.
- (k) <u>Unmarried Certificate</u>. Unmarried Certificate for candidates less than 21 years of age affixed with photograph (signed and stamped), issued by Village Sarpanch/ Municipal Corporation within last six months. (Format of Unmarried Certificate is attached as per Appendix 'C' with the Notification).
- (I) <u>Relationship Certificate</u>. SOS/SOEX/SOW/SOWW Candidates are required to produce the following documents:-
 - (i) Relationship certificate issued from respective Record Office only duly signed by Record Officer with Personal Number, Rank, Name and particular of the Record Officer issuing the Relationship Certificate with office seal/stamp is endorsed. Relationship certificate should bear water marks of the concerned Records.
 - (ii) A declaration to the effect as mentioned in Affidavit on Ten Rupees Non-Judicial Stamp paper prepared by the ESM duly signed by 1st Class/ Executive/ Judicial Magistrate is required to be submitted by the candidate at rally site. **Format of affidavit attached as per Appendix 'D'**.
 - (iii) Original Discharge Book of Ex-Serviceman also to be produced. Name and date of birth of the candidate must have been recorded in it.
- (m) NCC Certificate. NCC A/B/C certificate and Republic Day Parade certificate should have photograph of the candidate duly attested by issuing authority. Provisional NCC A/B/C pass certificate will only be accepted if authenticated by concerned NCC Group Commanders. No bonus marks are to be allotted unless the certificate (Relationship/ Sports/ NCC) have been verified. Provisional certificates are accepted only during the notified rally duration, neither earlier nor later.
- <u>Note</u>:- NCC certificate produced at the rally site only will be valid for bonus marks. No NCC certificate will be accepted after rally.

(n) Sports Certificate.

- (i) For list of sports under which relaxation in physical standards is admissible, attention is invited to www.joinindianarmy.nic.in website and **Appendix 'E'** of this notification.

- (o) <u>Affidavit</u>. Duly signed by candidate on Rs 10/- Non-judicial Stamp Paper as per specimen duly attested by notary will be submitted by candidate at the Rally Site without fail. Format of affidavit attached as per Appendix 'A'. Submission of Affidavit is mandatory for entry into the Rally. Candidates WILL NOT BE PERMITTED to enter the rally without affidavit. Incomplete affidavit will not be accepted. All details as applicable including records of participation of previous rallies must be duly filled up by typing.
- (p) <u>Certificate of Bonus Marks</u>. All original certificates/ photocopies duly attested pertaining to Bonus marks will be accepted only during the Rally. No certificate to include NCC Certificate, Sports Certificate, Relationship Certificate or any other certificates to claim Bonus Marks/ Relaxation would be accepted after termination of the Rally.

- (q) <u>Single Bank A/C, PAN Card & AADHAR Card</u>. Single Bank A/C, PAN Card & Aadhar Card are mandatory documents for final enrolment for the purpose of Pay & allowances and other social benefits scheme.
- (r) Sarpanch/ Nagar Sewak (Residence Proof) within last six months.
- (s) Additional Documents in Original Required From Students of Education Boards Other Than Those Listed at Serial Number 4 of Appendix 'B'. The Students of Education Boards other than those listed at serial number 4 of Appendix 'B' are advised to bring the maximum number of documents out of the following or any such similar documents to prove beyond doubt their credentials of being a domicile (native) of Bihar:-
 - (i) Latest House Electricity Bill.
 - (ii) Family Ration Card.
 - (iii) Bank Pass Book of Place of Residence.
 - (iv) Family Gas Connection Pass Book.
 - (v) Agriculture Land Ownership Document.
- (t) <u>Additional Certificates</u>. Candidates are also required to bring following certificates as applicable:-
 - (i) <u>Tattoo Certificate (If Applicable)</u>. For details, refer para 28 of the notification.
 - (ii) Non Use of Performance Enhancing Drugs Certificate. For details, refer para 26 of the notification.
 - (iii) <u>Indemnity Bond/ Certificate</u>. For details, refer para 24 of the notification.
 - (iv) COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate.
